## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The company **Portos e Caminhos de Ferro de Moçambique, E.P. (CFM)**, with over 125 years of experience in the development of the rail-port system, has developed and established this Environmental Policy. Its purpose is to continuously improve the responsible management of the environmental aspects of the company's activities, to prevent or minimise its negative environmental impacts and risks, to comply with the legal requirements and the applicable guidelines and good practices, and to raise the environmental awareness of all employees and other relevant stakeholders.

To achieve this, CFM adopts the following commitments and principles:

- Ensure that this Environmental Policy is communicated and understood by all levels within the organization and made available to stakeholders.
- Conduct activities guided by the mission and strategic vision, seeking service sustainability through responsible management of environmental aspects, grounded in the values of Good Governance, Efficiency, Credibility, and Social Responsibility.
- Establish and periodically review the Environmental Policy and the Environmental and Social Management System, ensuring continuous improvement of environmental performance.
- Develop and implement operational practices and procedures that comply with national policies and legislation and respect codes and guidelines issued by national

and international organisations as minimum requirements, applying the strictest standards wherever possible.

- All employees shall be involved and held accountable for compliance with the Environmental and Social Policy and for the implementation, maintenance and improvement of the Environmental and Social Management System, according to their roles and responsibilities within the company, and shall receive the necessary training to do so.
- Identify and assess the risks and impacts of all CFM activities, products and services with a view to mitigating adverse risks and impacts and enhancing beneficial ones.
- In mitigating adverse impacts on workers, affected communities and the environment, avoidance is the preferred option, with minimisation or compensation only where avoidance is not possible.
- Ensure appropriate engagement with communities in areas affected by CFM activities on issues that may have an impact on them.
- Delineate and implement actions aimed at preventing water wastage, reducing energy consumption, practicing rational use of raw materials, and creating, promoting, and maintaining green spaces.
- Identify and implement opportunities to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, thereby contributing to climate change mitigation.
- Ensure coordination with the national disaster risk management system and that the company's facilities and activities do not increase, but rather reduce, the vulnerability of communities to disaster risks and the effects of climate change.
- Prevention and control of pollutant releases into the air, water, and soil.
- Promotion of the reduction in the production of hazardous and non-hazardous waste and adoption of practices for reuse, recycling, and recovery of generated waste,



using environmentally safe practices for proper disposal when reuse, recycling, or recovery is not viable.

The Administration Board is committed to disseminating and ensuring compliance with the established Environmental Policy, as well as updating it in response to evolving institutional needs and external circumstances.
