Tariff Adjustment as a Result of the Increase in Fuel Prices

The entry into force of the new fuel prices in the country, as a result of the escalation of the armed conflict in the Middle East, has had a significantly adverse impact on CFM's operating costs, thereby compromising the normal continuity of services at the minimum level of efficiency required for this important and strategic sector of activity.

Diesel fuel, in particular, which is a critical component for the viability of rail and port operations, has experienced an increase of approximately 45.5%.

In this context, and with a view to mitigating the effects of this increase on the company's cost structure, while ensuring the maintenance of quality service delivery, CFM hereby informs all sectors involved in tariffing and invoicing, clearing and forwarding agents, as well as the general public, **of the approval of new tariffs for railway transport services, with overall increases ranging from 5% to 10%**, depending essentially on the type of cargo, specific railway corridor, and nature of the service.

Adjustments at the port level, **essentially covering shore handling and stevedoring, as well as ancillary services, have recorded increases ranging from 5% to 10%**. Maritime services, due to their specific nature, have undergone a more significant increase.

The annexes to this Public Notice, which form an integral part thereof, include the tables reflecting the adjustments at the port level.

This Public Notice shall enter into force on 1st of June 2026.
