The **Portos e Caminhos de Ferro de Moçambique, E.P. (Mozambique Ports and Railways)** has received financing from the New Partnership for Africa's Development - Infrastructure Project Preparation Facility (NEPAD IPPF), hosted by the African Development Bank, toward the cost of the **Environmental and Social Impact Studies Project**, and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to payments under the contract for the **Consultancy Services for Project Financial Audit for the period from 2021 to 2027**.

The main objective of this consultancy is to conduct an external audit of financial statements and to express a professional opinion of the financial position of the project at the end of each Fiscal Year (FY) regarding funds received and expenditures incurred for the relevant Fiscal Year, in accordance with the International Standards on Accounting (ISA) promulgated by the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC).

The estimated duration of the assignment is two (2.0) months from the date of contract commencement. The total level of effort for the assignment shall not exceed fifteen (15) professional working days.

The **Mozambique Ports and Railways (Portos e Caminhos de Ferro de Moçambique, E.P.)** now invite eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures,

description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may constitute joint-ventures to enhance their chances of qualification.

Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's ***"Procurement Policy for Bank group funded operations"*** which entered into force on October 2015 and is available on the Bank's website at <https://www.afdb.org/en/projects-and-operations/procurement/new-procurement-policy>.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Least Cost Selection (LCS) method set out in the Bank's Procurement Policy.
